The empirical study of the digital corpus of eleven Italian retranslations of Virginia Woolf's *To the Lighthouse* identifies a progressive source text orientation only in a relatively few aspects of a few target texts. The translator's presence affects all the examined target texts in terms of register and style under the influence of the Italian translation norms usually attributed to the translation of literary classics. Its intended readership comprises students of the mentioned fields and the general public of readers, editors, and publishers.
